PROCEDURES FOR INTERESTED PARTIES TO PRESENT TO BOARD ON APPEALS

Pursuant to CP-1, the ICC Board shall review each of the appeals and the reports of the Appeals Board and shall take appropriate action on each of the appeals. With respect to the appeals filed in connection with the 2019 Group B Cycle, the Board will hear from interested parties, in accordance with the following guidelines:

- It shall only be open to individuals who testified in the applicable appeal
- A registration process will be required to participate in the Board meeting
- Approximately 2hrs shall be allotted for hearing from participants
- Order of participants shall be: appellants, ICC staff, supporters, opponents
- Each appellant may speak for up to 15 minutes
- ICC staff may speak for up to 15 minutes
- Each of the supporters and opponents may speak for up to 5 minutes, provided however, if time doesn't allow for that, each of the supporters and opponents will equally share the remainder of time
- No redundant testimony will be allowed, regardless of whether you are an appellant, or otherwise testifying in support or opposition.
- No visual presentations will be allowed
- Board members may ask questions after each participant has completed his/her presentation
- No rebuttals shall be permitted
- The Board will go into executive session to deliberate and their decision on the appeal shall be announced on a later date
- The President of the Board has discretion to make amendments to this procedure as he deems reasonably appropriate
