- An educational session on the Safe Use of Modified Shipping Containers will include information from ICC Guideline 5: Guideline for the Safe Use of ISO Intermodal Shipping Containers

Repurposed as Buildings and Building Components. The session is led by Stephen Shang, CEO, Falcon Structures who was a member of the Guideline's development committee.
