Executive Order

PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, Indiana is committed to recognizing our growth and strength depends on the safety and economic value of the buildings that serve our citizens; and
- WHEREAS, our confidence in the structural integrity of these buildings that make up our community is achieved through the devotion of vigilant guardians—building safety and fire prevention officials, design professionals, builders, tradespeople, laborers and others in the construction industry—who work to ensure the safe construction of buildings; and
- WHEREAS, Building Safety Month is sponsored by the International Code Council to remind the public about the critical role of our communities' largely unknown guardians of public safety—our local code officials—who assure us of safe and usable buildings that are essential Indiana's prosperity; and
- WHEREAS, each year, in observance of Building Safety Month, Hoosiers are asked to consider the commitment to improve building safety and economic investment at home and in the community, and to acknowledge the essential service provided to all of us by local and state code officials and the Fire prevention and Building Safety Commission in protecting lives and property;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Eric J. Holcomb, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim the month of May, 2017 as

BUILDING SAFETY MONTH

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
